TECHNICAL INFORMATION & ANALYTICS

Our website uses cookies. A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.

Web servers can use cookies to identify and track users as they navigate different pages on a website and to identify users returning to a website. Cookies may be either "persistent" cookies or "session" cookies. A persistent cookie consists of a text file sent by a web server to a web browser, which will be stored by the browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date (unless deleted by the user before the expiry date). A session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of the user session when the browser is closed.

We use both session cookies and persistent cookies on our website

Cookies do not contain any information that personally identifies you, but personal information that we store about you may be linked, by us, to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.

We may use the information we obtain from your use of our cookies for the following purposes:

- to recognise your computer when you visit our website;
- to track you as you navigate our website, and to enable certain features, such as bookmarking content and logging in.
- to improve the website's usability;
- to analyse the use of our website;
- in the administration of this website;
- to prevent fraud and improve the security of the website;
- to personalise our website for you, including targeting advertisements which may be of interest to you.

When you use our website, you may also be sent third party cookies.

HOW WE STORE YOUR INFORMATION

The internet is not a secure medium, but we have put in place various security procedures to protect your data. We take the security and privacy of our customers' personal information extremely seriously and we have strict internal procedures which cover the storage, access, and disclosure of your information.

All information you provide to us is stored on our secure servers. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password which enables you to access certain parts of our site, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. You must not share your password with anyone.

YOU AND YOUR INFORMATION

The right of access

You are entitled receive confirmation as to whether your personal information is being processed by us, as well as various other information relating to our use of your personal information.

You also have the right to assess your personal information which we are handling a £10 fee may be applicable.

You have the right to require us to erase your personal information which we are handling in the following circumstances;

- we no longer need to use your personal information for the reasons we told you we collected it for
- You object to our use of your personal information and we have no compelling reason to carry on handling your personal information
- Our handling of your personal information has broken the law
- We must erase your personal information to comply with a law we are subject to.
- For marketing purposes if you ask us to stop handling your personal information on this basis, we will stop

How long we retain your Data for

Where you have contacted us for our services, we will hold your data if it is required to comply with our regulatory and statutory obligations to ensure that we are able to assist you in connection with any services we have provided to you.
